Dear Jr. and Sr. Division Coaches:

You are cordially invited to the Tiger Tournament hosted by Beechwood High School in Ft. Mitchell, KY. Our tournament will be held on **November 2, 2024,** at the combined Beechwood Elementary / High School campus.



REGISTRATION:

- Register on Tabroom.com or on this link: http://beechwood.tabroom.com
- The registration is now open, and the deadline is Tuesday 10/29 @ 9:00 pm. All student entries and judge entries must be in by this time.
- Congressional debate legislation is due by Friday 10/25 @ midnight. Email it to molly.seifert@beechwood.kyschools.us

CATEGORIES OFFERED:

- This tournament offers all KHSSL, Inc. speech events for the Junior and Senior divisions.
- This tournament offers Congress, but no LD or PFD due to space limitations.
- Please ensure that your judges are familiar with the rules in the updated KHSSL, Inc. Handbook.

ENTRIES:

- Teams may have unlimited entries; however, only the top three scores in each event will count toward team sweepstakes.
- Individual students may enter <u>no more than three events.</u>
- Students entered in Congress may enter one additional event that is not Extemp.

JUDGES:

- Each school must provide one judge per six entries. 1-6 entries = 1 judge; 7-12 entries = 2 judges; 13-18 entries = 3 judges, etc.
- If you are bringing Congress entries, please indicate which of your judges would be best-suited for Congress.
- No team can register without at least one judge.
- Your team may hire up to two judges at a cost of \$25 each. We'll need your judges!
- Tabroom will not allow you to register a judge who does not already have a Tabroom account linked to your team.
- A brief judge training will be provided the morning of the tournament, but it will not be an all-encompassing judge
 training. Judges should be familiar with the Tabroom website, how to complete online ballots, and the KHSSL rules
 prior to tournament day.
- Judges may be assigned to judge either Junior division events or Senior division events, so please notify your judges.
- We will use online ballots, so all judges should have a tablet or laptop on competition day. Judging on a phone is not
 ideal, and I will not have extra laptops available.
- In the past, tournament hosts have not been able to use judges from larger teams because those larger teams had students performing in every competition room. However, since this tournament offers both Junior and Senior divisions, every judge will have a judging assignment. Please plan accordingly and register only those judges who will actually be present on competition day.

FEES:

- Entry fees are \$6 per individual event. (Duo events are \$12).
- Student drop fees (\$5 for each drop past the registration deadline) begin Tuesday 10/29 @ 9:01 pm.
- Judge drop fees (\$25 for each drop past the registration deadline) begin Tuesday 10/29 @ 9:01 pm.

Please make checks out to Beechwood High School and have the check available at registration.

AWARDS:

- We will award medals for 1st 6th places.
- The top three teams in each division will receive a sweepstakes trophy.
