We are excited to reintroduce a Mid-Willamette Valley Dual Meet, combining for the 3rd year in a row the illustrious Sprague Invitational Debate Tournament and the Silverton Fox Invitational. All events - Debate AND Speech - will be held at the Sprague Campus. Hope to see you there!

SID Fox Information:

**The tournament will be held Saturday, November 2nd, 2024 at Sprague High School. We will offer all State IE and Debate events, including Student Congress, and will also offer NSDA Big Questions Debate.

**IE Awards will be given out to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place entries in Varsity and Novice Division. Certificates will be presented to finalists in all divisions.

**Debate Awards will be presented to undefeated teams as well as to one loss teams in all debate events except Congressional Debate where competitors will receive individual placement certificates and also outstanding chairs. Certificates will be given for outstanding individual speakers in debate. If numbers allow, we will present specific awards for all students who earn a leg in the state's alternate qualification system.

- Initial registration is due Monday, October 28th at 4:00 pm.
- Changes to your registration will be accepted until 5:00 pm on Wednesday, October 30th. Fees will be assessed at that time.
- Please get your complete registration in, including judges, as early as possible. Remember: it is always easier to drop students than to add them later.
- Late Drops: If you have drops after we close registration, we will allow you to make those yourself on Tabroom. However, we will assess fees on Wednesday the 1st at 5:00 pm; any drops made after that time will still be charged.

DIVISIONS:

- Novice Division: Limited to students with NO SPEAKING EXPERIENCE IN HIGH SCHOOL COMPETITION BEFORE THE 2024-2025 school year. (Students who went to camp may enter in this category).
- Junior Division: Limited to students in their first or second year of competition.
- Open/Senior Division: Open to all students.
- Congressional Debate and Big Question Debate will be Open Division Only!

Note: Divisions may be collapsed if there are insufficient entries. We will work hard to keep Novice separate.

- <u>LD Value</u> Resolved: The United States ought to adopt a wealth tax. *NO NOVICE TOPIC*
- <u>Policy</u> Resolved: The United States federal government should significantly strengthen its protection of domestic intellectual property rights in copyrights, patents, and/or trademarks.
- Parliamentary All topics will deal with current domestic and international events.
- <u>Public Forum</u> Resolved: The United States should substantially reduce its military support of Taiwan.
- <u>Big Question Debate</u> Resolved: Creativity is a more powerful force than intelligence.

CONFLICTS:

- 1. Students may enter 1 Pattern A Event and up to 2 Pattern B Events *at their own risk*. We do not recommend entering two 10-minute events in Pattern B.
- 2. Extemp - students who are entered in Extemp MAY NOT enter another IE. Extemp will prep in the hour of their pattern it will be important that Extempers are not late to the prep room!
- 3. Congress conflicts with everything; students doing Congress will not be able to enter other events.
- 4. CX conflicts with everything; students doing CX will not be able to enter other events.

Entry Limitations:

Sprague just isn't the biggest high school room-wise. Each school will be allocated 3 entries per division per event. Additional entries will be waitlisted. Tournament officials will connect with small entry schools to confirm if their allocated spots can be moved to accommodate waitlisted schools. Waitlist entries will be moved from the waitlist the Monday prior to the tournament if space allows. **Those with uncovered entries will be the first to be asked to adjust their registration, so please ensure that you are finding judges to cover your entries.**

FOOD:

RULES:

JUDGES:

*Each team must provide 1 coach available to supervise students and judge throughout the tournament. If your coach is unable to attend, or if they are going to be on the opposite campus for this day, please inform the tournament director of the name of the adult in charge by listing them on the Tabroom site for the appropriate tournament.
