# General Information

- 1. Deadlines: Registration for the tournament is now open and will end on Wednesday, October 30th at 5:00 PM. The deadline for drops and judge registration is Thursday, October 31st at 5:00 PM.
- 2. Entries: We host a double-entry tournament, excluding Group Discussion and Congressional Debate. In addition, any Speech competitors with the exception of those entered in Congressional Debate may also enter Multiple Reading.
- 3. Fees: There is a \$10 registration fee per entry; the fee for Duo, PF, and BQ will be \$20 per entry, while Multiple Reading is counted as one entry at the standard \$10. Fees may be paid in cash or by checks made out to "Revere High School".
- 4. Judges: For every five competitors (or fraction thereof) in speech events, each school must provide one judge. In Debate events, each school must provide one judge for every two competitors. Extra judges are always welcome. There is a \$50 fee to pay for a judge's drop or failure to cover your team's judging obligation.

Please remember that numbers of required judges are determined at the time of registration, not on the day of the tournament. All judges will need an electronic device, preferably a laptop, and will need to register for a free account at Tabroom.com as we will be using electronic balloting.

Do you have a song you relate to <u>so</u> much? Do you feel it on another level? Do you know all the lyrics? Perfect! Song Soliloquy is a unique event offered by RHS for all music lovers to enjoy!

Your piece must include the lyrics of any song, without any words added. The lyrics cannot be rearranged, though cutting is permissible, and all must come from the original song. There is no intro, but your performance must begin by stating the name of the song and its creator.

Performers are encouraged to use sincerity, emotion, and clarity. Feel free to play with the lyrics and tone! Make the happiest song ever extremely heartbreaking! Use your creativity! There's just one catch: no singing.

### **Group Discussion:**

The topic area will be: The 2024 Elections, with a focus on immigration, the economy, social issues, and Congressional elections.

### Radio Broadcasting:

copy will be from current national and international press sources

#### **Extemp:**

Topics will include international, national, and economic issues in preliminary rounds. The final focus will be on the 2024 Elections.



### **Big Questions:**

### **Public Forum:**
