Event Limitations

- Varsity students may register for only ONE limited prep event
- Per CCA Rules, 13 year students may only participate in 2 events
- Per CCA Rules, students are limited to 2 consecutive seasons of competing in Impromptu at one or more CCA tournaments pers season. This means that if you competed in impromptu last year, this is the only other year you can compete in impromptu. If this is your first year competing in impromptu, you will only be able to compete in impromptu this year and next year. A list of non-eligible students and those who began their two year eligibility was sent to each coach.

Scripts

- Interpretation and Public Address events must have a scrip for submission at student registration check-in. Read the IE Criteria & Competitor Standards under the Speech tab on the CCA website carefully to ensure your script is submitted properly.

A note about commitment:

Registration is a commitment to compete in the event. Dropping an event for any reason other than illness or family emergency must be done BEFORE registration closes. After that point, each competitor needs to follow through with his/her commitment to compete.
