FOR COMPETITORS:

- □ **Check-in-** first thing each day in Scharnberg Business and Communication Center (SBCC).
- Coolers- should be taken to the hangout area in Panda in the lower level of the Stevens Student Center (SSC). No one is permitted on the upper level of SSC.
- Belongings- keep your belongings tidy and throw your trash away.
- □ Do not go in buildings or rooms not used by CCA. Do not hang out in unused spaces.
- □ **JV and Junior competitors** should stay in their competition rooms until all have presented.
- □ Varsity IE: If you are cross-entered, go to the room in which you are listed earliest, then continue on to where you are listed next.
- Lost + Found will be located at the entrance of SBCC.



- During the Final Debate Round, show respect to our competitors by listening courteously and silently.
