Entries:

Each school may enter a maximum of 4 entries in each event. You may add additional entries to the waitlist and if room permits, we will add waitlisted entries. Entries will be handled on a first-come, first-served basis

Registration:

Registration will occur online on <u>tabroom</u>. Registration will be open from November 21st to December 11th. Judges may register until the end of the day on Friday, December 13th. Fees and drop lists are due by December 11th. Change fees apply to any changes after December 11th. *All times are in MST*.

Entry Fees:
