Judges

We will be utilizing online balloting through Tabroom. Please make sure all your Judges are set up on Tabroom and everyone brings an internet enabled device (computer, tablet, phone, etc.) to enter ballots. We will have a limited amount of Chromebooks to check out to judges that do not have a device.

It is also essential that your judges provide quality feedback in all rounds. Please ensure that your judges know this expectation! There is a 10 word requirement on all ballots, and you will not be able to submit your ballot without 10 words.
