The Connecticut Democracy Center Debate Tournament invites you to our first event of the 2024-25 season: the preliminary round of our Middle School Policy Debate Tournament.

All participating teams will argue both sides of the resolution: *Connecticut should lower the voting age to 16 for municipal elections.*

Rounds will be held in the Frank Center for Public Affairs on the Wesleyan University campus. Parking is available near the Admissions Building at 70 Wyllys Avenue Middletown. Signs indicating parking for the event, as well as signs directing debaters and coaches will be posted along the walking route from the lot to the location of debate rounds. Accessible parking is available near Allbritton Hall. Here is a link to the campus map from Wesleyan University.

Debaters and coaches must arrive by 3:30 pm for competition. Each school in attendance is required to provide judges to the preliminary round of the tournament.

Pizza and refreshments will be available for participants, coaches, judges, and families upon the conclusion of the second debate round.

Coaches and students sign up through Tabroom one month prior to the competition. For this Tournament, registration opens March 21, 2025. The cost to participate is \$25 per team; this fee includes food at the preliminary competition.

Registration closes at 8:00 p.m. on Thursday April 17, 2025 for the Tournament. Entries must be received via Tabroom for participation in the Tournament.

Payment may be collected by Connecticut Democracy Center staff on location at Wesleyan University prior to the beginning of the first round. Payment may be in cash or check, payable to The Connecticut Democracy Center. Payment must be presented to a CTDC staff member along with the full names of student team members as well as their school name.
