Item 1 – A Bill to Mandate the Use of Body Cameras for All Public School Teachers to Ensure Student Safety

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- **SECTION 1.** The use of body cameras for all public school teachers is hereby mandated to ensure student safety and accountability.
- **SECTION 2.** "Body cameras" refer to wearable recording devices that capture audio and video footage.
- **SECTION 3.** The Department of Education will oversee the implementation and regulation of this mandate.
 - A. Schools must provide body cameras to all teachers and ensure their use during school hours.
 - B. Violations will result in fines up to \$10,000 per incident.
 - C. Recorded footage will be stored securely and accessed only for investigations of misconduct or safety incidents.
- **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on July 1, 2026. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

Item 2 - A Bill to Legalize the Commercial Harvesting of Whale Blubber for Renewable Energy Production

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- **SECTION 1.** The commercial harvesting of whale blubber is hereby legalized for the purpose of renewable energy production.
- SECTION 2. "Whale blubber" refers to the thick layer of fat found under the skin of whales, which can be processed into biofuel.
- **SECTION 3.** The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) will oversee the regulation and sustainability of this practice.
 - A. Harvesting quotas will be established to prevent overexploitation.
 - B. Violations will result in fines up to \$100,000 per incident.
 - C. Annual reports on the environmental impact and sustainability of whale blubber harvesting will be published.
- **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2026. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

Item 3 - A Resolution to Mandate the Labeling of Lab-Grown Meat to Inform Consumers

- WHEREAS, Lab-grown meat, also known as cultured meat, is becoming increasingly available as an alternative to traditional meat; and
- WHEREAS, There is ongoing debate about the health, environmental, and ethical implications of lab-grown meat; and
- WHEREAS, Consumers have the right to know the origins and production methods of the food they consume; and
- WHEREAS, Mandating the labeling of lab-grown meat can provide transparency and allow consumers to make informed choices; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the Congress here assembled encourages the mandatory labeling of lab-grown meat to inform consumers about its origins and production methods; and, be it
- **FURTHER RESOLVED,** That the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) will oversee the implementation and enforcement of this labeling requirement.
