A Bill to Rehabilitate the Public Criminal Defense System

1	BE IT ENACTE	D BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
2	SECTION 1.	Public defenders shall no longer be allowed to work contemporaneously or
3		more than 30 felony cases, or no more than 65 misdemeanor cases.
4	SECTION 2.	In the event that a public defender is taking a hybrid of felony and
5		misdemeanor cases contemporaneously, the public defender shall be
6		limited to 45 cases in total, while taking on less than 20 felony cases.
7	SECTION 3.	The Department of Justice (DOJ) shall oversee the implementation and
8		enforcement of this bill. The DOJ shall create a committee that will oversee
9		the allocation of funds to states to aid with the hiring of more public
10		defenders, and retention of public defenders.
11		A) 2 billion dollars shall be allotted to this committee per annum for the
12		sake of hiring more public defenders.
13		B) 1 billion dollars shall be allocated to this committee per annum for the
14		sake of retaining public defenders, through increased wages.
15		C) Further funds may be allocated at the next Congressional budgetary
16		meeting.
17	SECTION 4.	This legislation will take effect on FY27. All laws in conflict with this
18		legislation are hereby declared null and void
