## **Public Transportation Act**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

| 1  | SECTION 1. | Every metropolitan area within the United States shall be required to         |

| 4  | SECTION 2. | A metropolitan area shall be defined as a city or a city with bordering       |
| 5  |            | municipalities with a population of 50,000 or more.                           |
| 6  |            | Public Transportation shall be defined as a system of trains, buses, or taxis |
| 7  |            | that is paid for or run by the government.                                    |

| 9  | SECTION 3. | Each metropolitan area shall be required to have some form of public          |
| 10 |            | transportation easily accessible by all of its residents.                     |
| 11 |            | A. People under the age of 18 or are currently in school shall not be         |
| 12 |            | required to pay for using public transportation during the school             |
| 13 |            | year  |
| 14 | SECTION 4. | The United States Department of Transportation shall allocate 5 billion       |
| 15 |            | dollars for funding of public transportation in metropolitan areas.           |
| 16 |            | A. Funds shall be requested by metropolitans area to use for the              |
| 17 |            | establishment of public transportation  |
| 18 |            | B. Any metropolitan area that uses a private company in substitution          |
| 19 |            | for a city ran public transportation shall be ineligible to receive           |
| 20 |            | federal funding unless they end their contract with the respective            |
| 21 |            | company   |
| 22 | SECTION 5. | The United States Department of Transportation shall be responsible for the   |
| 23 |            | enforcement of this legislation.  |
| 24 | SECTION 6. | Any metropolitan area that does not comply shall be ineligible to receive     |
| 25 |            | federal funding for forms of public transportation in the future.             |
| 26 | SECTION 7. | This legislation shall go into effect on April 9, 2025.                       |
