The Cardinal Forensics Team invites you to attend the HHS Invitational Forensics Tournament on **Saturday, March 29**. You may bring up to **24 entries**. The following events will be offered:

- Extemporaneous Speech  
(Domestic and Foreign)
- Informative Speech 7
- Informative Speech 10
- Original Oration
- Impromptu Speech
- Poetry Interpretation
- Prose Interpretation
- Program of Oral Interp (POI)
- Humorous Solo Acting
- Serious Solo Acting
- Duet Acting (Duo)
- Improvised Duet Acting (IDA)

### **Schedule and Tournament Information:**

- There will be 3 preliminary rounds and one final round.
- The top six in each event will receive medals.
- Finalists and final rankings will be determined from their **cumulative totals**.
- *Sweepstakes* will be based on the ***top 12 entries from the 3 preliminary rounds***.
- There will be no minimum entry to qualify for the team sweepstakes.
- There will be plaques for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place sweepstakes awards.
- **Each student is limited to three events and may not enter twice in the same event.**

**NOTE: Students may enter only one “Draw” or “Preparation” event, with the exception of Impromptu.**

- I ask that for every 12 entries, you bring one extra judge, besides the coach.

**Event Information:**

- I will not be splitting Duo Interp and Duet Acting. Duet Acting Ballots will be used!
- I will split Extemp if we receive enough entries. There will be both domestic and foreign topic envelopes to draw from.
- I will split Informative 7 & 10 if we receive enough entries. If the numbers do not justify it, informative will be combined USING the KSHSAA Informative Speech rules. (No visuals).
- **The combination of events will happen on March 14 at 4:00 PM, if the registration numbers reflect we need to combine events (Extemp and INFO)**
- **Extra entries past 24 per team will be allowed once I look at the event caps and rooms available on March 14.**

**Drops:**

- **You must let us know if you are dropping no later than Monday, March 24th, or you will forfeit your entry fees and be responsible for paying them.**

**Entry Fees:**

- **Fees will be \$8 per person per entry. (IDA and Duos are \$16)**
