Coaches and sponsors,

We are excited to be hosting the district CX debate contest this year. We anticipate everything will run smoothly and without delay for the event.

Since this is a school day and all campuses are active, we do not have a district facility available to host. However, Calvary Baptist Church has graciously agreed to serve as host to provide the location for the contest to take place. Their address is 410 N Marshall St, Henderson, TX 75652. This address will take you to the Northwest side of the campus. You will need to follow the arrows on the map to the Southeast side of the campus for parking and entry to the building.

Included with this letter is an aerial map of the church campus showing the best way to enter and where to park on the campus. The building entry is also indicated with an arrow near the parking lot.

All events will take place in the wing of the building with the gym/family life center. The holding area will be downstairs in the gym. This is the only acceptable location for food or drinks. Tables and chairs will be provided for students and coaches not competing. Please be respectful and keep this area clean and all trash thrown away properly. There are restroom facilities available down the hall.

All competition rooms will be down the hall and upstairs in classrooms 240-245. Classrooms upstairs will be equipped with a judges desk/table and a table for the competing teams to share. Restroom facilities will also be available upstairs where the classrooms are located. A Judges hospitality location will also be upstairs. Only judges should be in this location.

Surge protectors/extension cords will be provided in each room for the debate tables and Wifi will be available. Appropriate use of the church provided internet/wifi services are expected.

Again, we are excited to host the district CX contest this year. We are also extremely grateful for Calvary Baptist Church opening their doors to allow us to host the event as well. Please help us show that gratitude by keeping their facilities clean and being respectful of the amenities they are providing.
