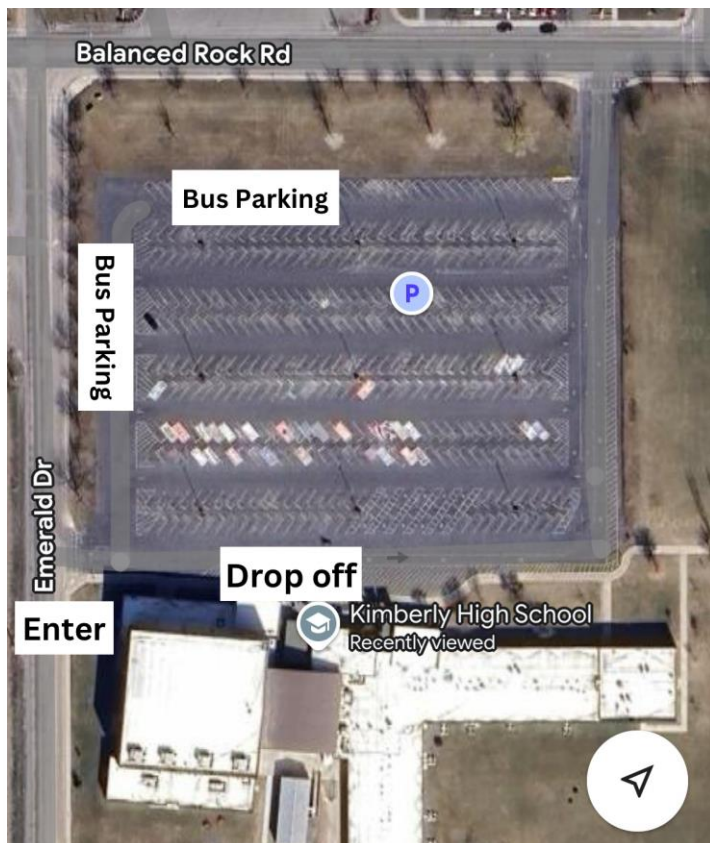
Welcome Meetings/Registration

Registration will begin at 12:30 by the high school gym, but please do not arrive before then. Competitors will all gather in the high school gymnasium for the welcome meeting, but the student hang out will be in the high school cafeteria after school dismissal. Judges will gather in the middle school cafeteria for the judge meeting. Our school gets out at 1:20, so there will be a shuffle of people around that time.

Bus Arrival

Buses need to enter the West side of the parking lot off Emerald Drive (or N 3450 E). They will then drop off in front of the first set of entrance doors at the high school. Buses will park on the North (back) side of the high school parking lot or the West side. DO NOT park on the East side or at the Middle school. That is where Kimberly school buses will pick up students. If you arrive late (after 1:20), the KSD buses will be in front of the school for pick up. Buses can still drop off at normal drop off spot, but there will be a lot of congestion with student dismissal and pick up. Please try your hardest to arrive before 1:20 to avoid that mess. (Some GPS maps take people to the district office in the center of town, so make sure you're at the right destination.)

Judge Info

Judges will gather in the middle school cafeteria for the judge meeting. They are welcome to park on the East side of the high school parking lot (closer to the middle school) or at the middle school if there is room. The middle school is extremely close to the high school (think of it as the average distance of school's portable), so it is not a long walk. The cafeteria is through the right entrance of the middle school.

Food

Food trucks will be available both days as concessions, but we will of course also have food for judges/coaches in the judge lounges. We are also located next-door to a Subway.

Competition Rooms, Judge Lounges, and Tabroom
