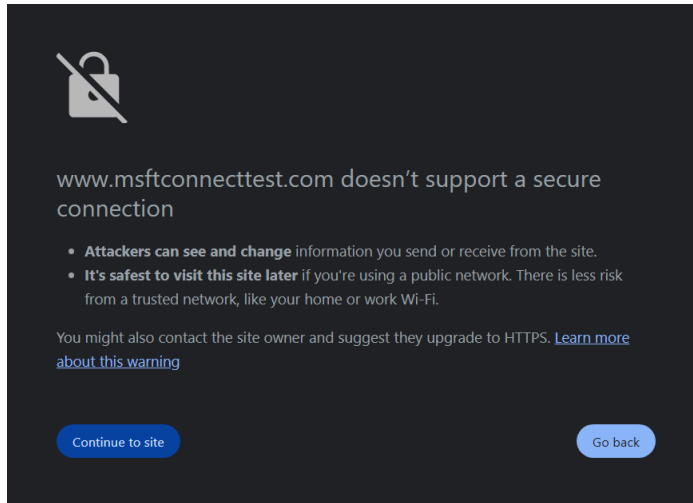


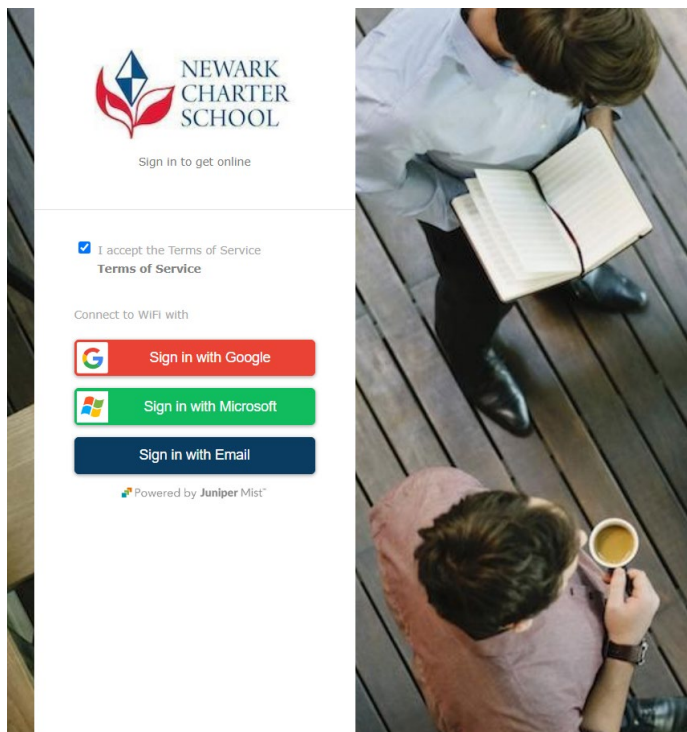
NCS Guest Access is the WiFi SSID that everyone would connect to.

If someone tries to connect on a laptop, they will see this message:




Have them click the button 'Continue to site'.
