

Brookfield East Spartan Invitational

Enter via tabroom. Call if you have issues. Note that this tournament will run in conjunction with the MCFL Qualifier (registration for the qualifier can also be made on tabroom according to the invite); therefore, entries will be limited.

NOTE: We will be testing out some technology at this tournament: using online ballots (with paper critique sheets) and online posting of schedules. Please bear with us, as these changes can make tournaments run faster, smoother, and with fewer errors. Judges should bring some internet connected device (laptop, smartphone, tablet, etc) so that they can enter ranks online. They will also need accounts on tabroom.com. Such technology use is voluntary but we are encouraging ALL JUDGES TO PARTICIPATE.

Entries

Double entry will be allowed in all events, as space permits. For sweepstakes, we'll take a team's top 25 entries with a maximum of 4 in a single event to calculate cumulative points. I'll open congress for those not attending the qualifier; however, without sufficient entries the event will be cancelled.

We will also offer Impromptu Speaking, in addition to all WFCA events.

Fees

\$10 each for single events. \$15 each for Play Acting, Duo, or Group Interp. \$16 for Congress.

Judges

One (1) well-trained judge for every 5 entries, or fraction thereof. *You may hire out judges at \$40 per uncovered entry.* Please remind judges that everyone is obligated through finals and it is possible that they will be asked to judge NCFL events. Such requests will be voluntary and infrequent. They must be familiar with WFCA rules and respect the practices of the tournament. Coaches will receive copies of some of their judges ballots for review.

Awards

Medals to finalists. Trophies to top three in each event. Sweepstakes awards will be given to the top teams in their respective entry number brackets. In the interest of respect, packets and awards will NOT be mailed or released before awards, save for extenuating circumstances. Results will be available on tabroom.com and will be emailed to coaches.

Food

There will be food. It will be delicious. Hospitality provided for judges. Vegetarian options will be plentiful.
