## A Bill to Rebuild and Re-Fund USAID

- 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
- 2 **SECTION 1.** The United States Agency for International Development (USAID) shall immediately resume  
3 normal business, with all responsibilities and functions from before its recent closure  
4 restored entirely. Congress shall also resume full funding for USAID, with a 25% increased  
5 budget for the next 365 days to help the agency repair damage done by its closure.
- 6 **SECTION 2.** The President shall henceforth require Congressional approval prior to cutting funding to  
7 USAID.
- 8 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be overseen by the Government Accountability Office (GAO).
- 9 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.
- 10 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

# A Bill to Create a National Telehealth Infrastructure Initiative

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The United States shall establish a National Telehealth Infrastructure  
3 Initiative to expand access to remote healthcare services nationwide.

4 A. The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and the Department  
5 of Health and Human Services (DHHS) shall coordinate to:

6 a. Expand broadband access in rural and underserved communities;

7 b. Provide grants to healthcare providers to acquire telehealth  
8 technology and training;

9 c. Ensure Medicare and Medicaid reimbursement parity for  
10 approved telehealth services.

11 B. Priority funding shall be directed to rural areas, Tribal communities,  
12 and medically underserved and vulnerable populations.

13 **SECTION 2.** Definitions:

14 A. "Telehealth" means the delivery of healthcare services through digital  
15 communication technologies, including video consultation and  
16 remote monitoring.

17 B. "Broadband" means high speed internet services sufficient enough to  
18 support real time video communication.

19 **SECTION 3.** The DHHS and FCC shall be responsible for enforcing this act

20 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on FY 2027. All laws in conflict with this  
21 legislation are hereby declared null and void.

## The Northwest Passage Integrity Act

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** Congress hereby reiterates unconditionally and with no uncertainty that the Northwest  
3 Passage—that is, those oceanic waterways connecting the Atlantic and Arctic Oceans via  
4 the Canadian Arctic Archipelago—to be international waters that United States vessels may  
5 navigate at any time and for any reason without seeking or obtaining permission from  
6 Canada.

7 **SECTION 2.** Congress authorizes the President to arm vessels traversing the Northwest Passage so that  
8 they may defend themselves from any foreign threats from those seeking to contest this  
9 right.

10 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be jointly overseen by the Department of Commerce and the  
11 Department of Defense.

12 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.

13 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

# A Bill to Create a Federal Rural Hospital Stabilization Fund

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The United States shall establish a Federal Rural Hospital Stabilization  
3 Fund to provide financial assistance to rural hospitals at risk of closure.

4 A. The Department of Health and Human Services shall administer the  
5 Fund and distribute grants to eligible hospitals based on  
6 demonstrated financial distress and community need.

7 B. Grant funds may be used for:

- 8 a. Maintaining emergency and inpatient services;  
9 b. Upgrading critical medical equipment;  
10 c. Recruiting and retaining healthcare professionals;  
11 d. Expanding essential services, including maternity and trauma care.

12 **SECTION 2.** In one of the sections, you may define ambiguous terms not obviously  
13 clear or technical in nature (consult U.S. Code [uscode.house.gov](http://uscode.house.gov) if  
14 necessary).

15 **SECTION 3.** Funding and Enforcement

16 A. The Department of Health and Human Services shall be responsible  
17 for enforcing this legislation.

18 B. This legislation will be funded via normal means..

19 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on 1 October 2027. All laws in conflict with  
20 this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

## A Bill to Ban Humanoid Robots

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** All robots manufactured, sold, or utilized in the United States and its territories must be  
3 distinctly non-human in appearance.

4 **SECTION 2.** Any humanoid robots found within the United States and its territories will be immediately  
5 impounded and destroyed by the Department of Homeland Security (DHS). States and  
6 territories are directed to determine additional criminal penalties in such situations.

7 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be overseen by DHS, with the National Commission on Robotics  
8 serving in an advisory capacity, especially concerning determinations as to what constitutes  
9 humanoid.

10 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.

11 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

## A Bill to Mandate Green Self-Powered AI Data Centers

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** All AI data centers are henceforth forbidden from drawing from existing electricity grids or  
3 even from being physically connected to them at all. Rather, AI data centers must produce  
4 any electricity they require onsite through environmentally sustainable methods, including  
5 but not limited to solar panels and wind turbines.

6 **SECTION 2.** For the purposes of this legislation, an AI data center is defined as a data center operating  
7 with the primary purpose of housing, training, and/or delivering artificial intelligence  
8 services.

9 **SECTION 3.** Any corporation operating an AI data center in violation of this legislation shall be fined \$1  
10 million and have all relevant operational licensing immediately revoked until such time as  
11 compliance is reached.

12 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall be overseen by the Department of Energy, which agency shall be  
13 specifically tasked with determining which energy sources are acceptable for AI data  
14 centers.

15 **SECTION 5.** This legislation shall take effect at the start of the next fiscal year.

16 **SECTION 6.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

## A Bill to Activate the Draft

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** The Military Selective Service Act is hereby amended to authorize the President to begin  
3 inducting personnel into the Armed Forces for the purpose of supporting our nation's  
4 military efforts in Iran, Venezuela, and any other theaters of war that may open up in the  
5 near future.

6 **SECTION 2.** The President is given full authority to determine details concerning how many persons  
7 shall be drafted, which persons are eligible, and how these persons shall be selected.

8 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be overseen by the Selective Service System (SSS).

9 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.

10 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

# A Bill to Establish a National Apprenticeship Tax Credit for Skilled trades

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** A federal tax credit shall be established for employers who sponsor  
3 registered apprenticeship programs in skilled trades.

4 A. Eligible employers shall receive a tax credit equal to a percentage of  
5 wages paid to apprentices during their first period of training, not to  
6 exceed the limit determined by the Secretary of the Treasury

7 B. Apprenticeship programs must:

8 a. Be registered with the Department of Labor;

9 b. Provide structured, paid, on-the-job training;

10 c. Include classroom or technical instruction related to the trade.

11 **SECTION 2.** Definitions:

12 A. "Skilled trades" include but are not limited to construction,  
13 manufacturing, electrical work, plumbing, welding, and advanced  
14 technical trades.

15 B. "Registered apprenticeship" refers to a program approved by the  
16 Department of Labor.

17 **SECTION 3.** Funding and enforcement: The Department of Labor and the Department  
18 of the Treasury shall jointly administer this act.

19 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on 1 January 2027. All laws in conflict with  
20 this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
