Where is the Round Robin?

The Round Robin will take place at the J. Wayne Reitz Union at the University of Florida campus. The address for the Reitz Union is **686 Museum Rd**, **Gainesville**, **FL 32611**.

When is the Round Robin?

The Round Robin will take place on **Thursday, October 30st, 2025**. **Registration and breakfast will be from 7:30 AM to 11:00 AM** in the Reitz Union, at Rion Ballroom East, located on the third floor of the Reitz Union.

The first judge call will be at 7:45 AM for both debate and speech. Please make sure your judges are in Rion West by 7:45AM and for the rest of the day during judge call. Schools will be fined \$50 per round that a judge does not appear at judge call for. Rounds will start promptly at 8 AM. Please reference your event's section for the schedule. We hope to start the Award Ceremony and Banquet by 7:00 PM.

Judging

The judging requirement is one per entry. Please go to <u>Tabroom</u> to fill out a form and paradigm for each judge.

We expect that teams and competitors who are accepted into the Round Robin bring experienced judges with speech and debate background. However, we understand that is not always possible. Competitors should be assured that the Florida Blue Key Speech and Debate team has worked very hard to provide a pool of fully capable judges.

<u>Schools will be fined \$50 per round that a judge does not appear at judge call for.</u> When judges do not show up at judge call, the entire Round Robin falls behind. For this reason, fines will be strictly enforced.

Evidence Rules

We will be following the latest evidence rules that have been created by the NSDA. Breaching these rules will be subject to disqualification.

Generative A.I Policy

For all events, if competitors are demonstrably found to use generative A.I. such as ChatGPT to write a significant portion of their speech, they will be reported to tab, pending disqualification. This does not disqualify them from using AI for outlines, or research; however, we discourage any use at all, to avoid penalty. All final decisions are at the discretion of our Tournament Chair and Round Robin Directors.

Congress

We'll be hosting a morning hour, followed by one preliminary session, with a top 7 break to finals. Our Congress staff will be presiding officers for your chambers, as to avoid skews in ranking.

Judges will be required to be at the Extemp draw room at 7:45 to receive training on crossfire in Extemp.
