

A Resolution to Collaborate Against Climate Change by Repealing Tariffs on Chinese Electric Vehicles (EVs)

- 1 **WHEREAS,** China has a booming electric vehicle (EV) industry and developed the
2 public infrastructure necessary to support it; and
- 3 **WHEREAS,** As countries like the United States and China switch to renewable energy,
4 electric vehicles become a more and more effective method to reduce
5 transportation emissions; and
- 6 **WHEREAS,** America has levied sanctions on Chinese vehicles and green technology,
7 including a 100% tariff on Chinese EVs, as well as substantial tariffs on
8 component imports from China such as lithium-ion batteries and solar
9 cells; and
- 10 **WHEREAS,** This tactic protects the American auto industry at the expense of global
11 climate progress by thwarting the trade of cheap, competitive, and clean
12 EVs; and
- 13 **WHEREAS,** Climate change and the accompanying consequences, such as natural
14 disasters and sea level rise, can only be mitigated with cooperative
15 international action; therefore, be it
- 16 **RESOLVED,** By the Congress here assembled that the US lower tariffs on the import of
17 Chinese electric vehicles (EVs), lithium-ion EV batteries, and photovoltaic
18 solar cells down to 10%.

A Bill to Free Myanmar from Tyranny

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The United States pledges military and humanitarian support to the National
3 Unity Government of Myanmar (NUG) and its armed wing, the People's
4 Defense Force (PDF), in the revolution against Myanmar's military junta, the
5 Tatmadaw.

6 **A)** 200 million dollars in military aid shall be delivered to the the People's
7 Defense Force, including but not limited to: drones, small arms, mortars,
8 ammunition, and stationary and portable air defense systems.

9 **B)** An additional 200 million dollars in humanitarian aid shall be delivered to
10 the National Unity Government, including but not limited to: food, water,
11 medical supplies, vaccines, first aid equipment, infrastructure development
12 and repair.

13 **C)** With approval of the DOD, the People's Defense Force may redistribute
14 military aid to ethnic armed organizations represented in the National Unity
15 Government, including but not limited to: the Kachin Independence Army,
16 the Arakan Army, and the Ta'ang National Liberation Army.

17 **SECTION 2.** The Department of Defense (DOD) and Department of State (DOS) shall be
18 responsible for implementing this bill. Funding shall be redirected from
19 discretionary spending allocated to the DOD.

20 **SECTION 3.** This legislation will take effect upon passage. All laws in conflict with this
21 legislation are hereby declared null and void.
