A Bill to Reverse and Prevent Intercensal Redistricting

1	BE IT ENACTED BY	THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2	SECTION 1.	Congressional redistricting shall henceforth be limited to that which
3		occurs automatically following each constitutionally-mandated decennial
4		census. States shall be prohibited from engaging in any additional
5		redistricting outside of this process.
6	SECTION 2.	Any redistricting implemented since the most recent census is hereby
7		nullified, with any affected districts reverting to their form as set as a
8		direct result of the 2020 Census.
9	SECTION 3.	This legislation shall be jointly overseen by the Department of Justice and
10		the Census Bureau.
11	SECTION 4.	This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.
12	SECTION 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Increase Equity and Authenticity in College Admissions

1	BE IT ENACTED E	Y THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2	SECTION 1.	As a condition of accreditation, no institute of higher education within
3		the United States and its territories may request or consider any
4		student's scores on the SAT as part of its admissions process.
5	SECTION 2.	An institute of higher education is defined as a college, university, or
6		other entity that provides education after high school. The SAT refers to
7		the standardized test owned, developed, and published by the College
8		Board and administered by Educational Testing Services.
9	SECTION 3.	This legislation shall be overseen by the Department of Education.
10	SECTION 4.	This legislation shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
11	SECTION 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

An Act to Award a Congressional Gold Medal to Rudy Giuliani

1	BE IT ENACTED B	Y THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2	SECTION 1.	The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro
3		Tempore of the Senate shall make appropriate arrangements for the
4		award, on behalf of Congress, of a gold medal of appropriate design to
5		Rudolph William Louis Giuliani, in recognition of his service to our
6		nation's largest city during its darkest hour, as well as to the country as a
7		whole during multiple presidential administrations.
8	SECTION 2.	As soon as may be arranged, this award shall be presented to Mayor
9		Giuliani at a ceremony planned for this purpose.
10	SECTION 3.	For the purpose of the award referred to in Section 1, the Secretary of
11		the Treasury (referred to in this Act as the "Secretary") shall strike a gold
12		medal with suitable emblems, devices, and inscriptions to be determined
13		by the Secretary.
14	SECTION 4.	There is authorized to be charged against the United States Mint Public
15		Enterprise Fund such amounts as may be necessary to pay for the costs of
16		the medals struck under this Act. The Secretary may strike and sell
17		duplicates in bronze of the gold medal described in Section 2 under such
18		regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, at a price sufficient to cover
19		the cost thereof, including labor, materials, dies, use of machinery, and
20		overhead expenses, and the cost of the gold medal. The amounts
21		received from the sale of duplicate medals shall be deposited in the
22		United States Mint Public Enterprise Fund.
