	SECTION 1.	An empowered and respected labor force being necessary

A Bill to Jumpstart Domestic Rubber Production

1	BE IT ENACTED B	Y THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2	SECTION 1.	Congress shall establish a fund of \$2 billion per year for each of the next
3		five years to increase domestic rubber production toward a goal of
4		rubber independence.
5	SECTION 2.	These funds shall be used to increase farming of guayule (Parthenium
6		argentatum), Russian dandelion (Taraxacum kok-saghyz), and any other
7		plants that may be used to produce rubber, as well as to build additional
8		factories for the processing and refinement of rubber. These funds may
9		also be used to expand and improve any infrastructure deemed
10		necessary to this goal.
11	SECTION 3.	This legislation shall be overseen by the Department of Agriculture, which
12		shall be responsible for disbursing and monitoring the use of these funds.
13	SECTION 4.	This legislation shall take effect on January 1, 2026.
14	SECTION 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Remove the Social Security Cap

1	BE IT ENACTED BY	THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2	SECTION 1.	All payroll earnings shall henceforth be subject to the Social Security
3		payroll tax, regardless of how much those earnings total each year.
4	SECTION 2.	This legislation shall be jointly overseen by the Internal Revenue Service
5		(IRS) and the Social Security Administration (SSA), with the latter
6		organization specifically tasked with determining appropriate rates for
7		those income levels that were not covered before this point.
8	SECTION 3.	This legislation shall take effect on January 1, 2026.
9	SECTION 4.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
