## A Bill to Provide Milk Choice in Schools

1	BE IT ENACTED E	BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2	SECTION 1.	All public schools in the United States and its territories shall henceforth
3		provide raw milk as an option for students during breakfast and lunch.
4	SECTION 2.	For the purposes of this legislation, raw milk shall be defined as the
5		unpasteurized milk of a cow.
6	SECTION 3.	Schools may determine based on demand precisely how much raw milk
7		to provide at each meal, but it must be a reliable option for children and
8		families who desire it.
9	SECTION 4.	This legislation shall be jointly overseen by the Department of Education
10		and the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).
11	SECTION 5.	This legislation shall take effect on January 1, 2026.
12	SECTION 6.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

## A Resolution to Request International Judicial Intervention for the Sep. 1 Caribbean Boat Attack

1	WHEREAS,	On September 2, 2025, President Donald Trump announced that the U.S.
2		Navy had one day prior attacked and destroyed a Venezuelan vessel in
3		international waters, murdering all 11 people onboard; and
4	WHEREAS,	This attack happened without any clear evidence of the specious claims
5		that the Trump administration has made to justify it; and
6	WHEREAS,	Even if those claims were proven to be accurate, this action remains
7		highly questionable under international law and sets a dangerous
8		precedent for how the United States and other nations interact with one
9		another, particularly given that Secretary of State Marco Rubio has
10		indicated that the United States intends to continue to undertake attacks
11		of this sort in the future; and
12	WHEREAS,	Actions such as these could very well boil over into military conflict if not
13		promptly and properly addressed through diplomatic means; now,
14		therefore be it
15	RESOLVED,	by the Congress here assembled that the International Court of Justice
16		(ICJ) is called upon to initiate proceedings involving the United States and
17		Venezuela to examine this incident, mediate any disputes, and ensure
18		that justice is served; and be it
19	FURTHER RESOLV	<b>YED,</b> that Congress also calls upon the International Criminal Court
20		(ICC) to investigate the actions of President Trump, Secretary of
21		Defense/War Pete Hegseth, and other relevant figures to determine
22		whether any charges of war crimes or other international transgressions
23		against these officials might be appropriate; and be it
24	FURTHER RESOLV	YED, that Congress commits to doing everything in its power to ensure
25		our nation's full cooperation with whatever actions these courts deem
26		appropriate.

## A Bill to Update Maps

1	BE IT ENACTED I	BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2	SECTION 1.	The use of the Mercator Projection shall be eliminated in maps within all
3		agencies and offices of the federal government, particularly those maps
4		that are on display. These maps shall be replaced with ones that utilize
5		the Gall-Peters Projection or, where practicable, globes.
6	SECTION 2.	Only when necessary for navigational purposes shall the continued use of
7		the Mercator Projection be permitted.
8	SECTION 3.	This legislation shall be overseen by the U.S. Geological Survey.
9	SECTION 4.	This legislation shall take effect on January 1, 2026.
10	SECTION 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
