A Bill to Ensure Competency in the Department of Education

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** No individual shall serve in any decision-making role within the
3 Department of Education without having attained a bare minimum of
4 experience as an educator within the United States and its territories.

5 **SECTION 2.** A decision-making role shall be defined as any role that empowers the
6 individual holding it to affect education policy in any way whatsoever,
7 however minute. A bare minimum of experience as an educator shall be
8 defined as at least thirty (30) cumulative days within a six-month period
9 spent as a classroom teacher, including substitute teaching, with no
10 statute of limitations on this requirement.

11 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall not apply to any persons currently working for the
12 Department of Education but only to all future appointees and hires.

13 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall be overseen by the Department of Education.

14 **SECTION 5.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.

15 **SECTION 6.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Demand Accountability from the UN

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** Until the United Nations (UN) has appropriately investigated and
3 remediated recent acts of disrespect, inadvertent or not, against the
4 United States and our leaders, Congress shall halt all funding of this
5 organization.

6 **SECTION 2.** This legislation shall be overseen by the Department of Justice, which
7 shall be tasked with determining when its terms have been satisfied so
8 that funding may be resumed.

9 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.

10 **SECTION 4.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Invest in Meteorite Prevention

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** The Department of Defense is hereby directed to utilize their resources
3 to make meteorite prevention a priority. Congress shall expect within five
4 years a comprehensive report from the Department of Defense detailing
5 a variety of protocols they have made ready to engage against
6 approaching meteorites of all shapes and sizes.

7 **SECTION 2.** Congress encourages the Department of Defense to spearhead and
8 engage consistently in international collaboration in pursuit of these
9 goals.

10 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be overseen by the Department of Defense.

11 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.

12 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
