

A Bill to Make Students Prepared for War

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1 **SECTION 1.** In order to strengthen the next generation's ability to fight wars, the United
2 States shall make it mandatory for students in grade 11 to learn
3 military-related skills, such as gun-using and ambush, lasting 2-3 weeks
4 with students staying in dormitories. The camps that the students go to will
5 undergo strict testing and inspection.

6 **SECTION 2.** Dormitories are defined as a bedroom designed for 3-4 people in an
7 institution.

8 **SECTION 3.** The US Department of Education (DE), Department of Defense (DOD),
9 Department of Homeland Security (DHS) will enforce and oversee it,
10 funded by the government

11 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on January 1st, 2026.

A Resolution to Amend the Constitution to Require Term Limits in Congress

1 **RESOLVED,** By two-thirds of the Congress here assembled, that the following article is
2 proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the United States, which
3 shall be valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
4 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several states within
5 seven years from the date of its submission by the Congress:

ARTICLE --

7 **SECTION 1:** All members of the House of Representatives will be able to
8 serve three terms at most, and members of the Senate will
9 serve two terms at most starting from the time this
10 legislation passes.

11 **SECTION 2:** A term in the House or Senate is the length of time each
12 Congressman serves until they are up for reelection, which
13 is two years in the House and six years in the Senate.
14 Representatives may run again as Senators, and vice versa.

SECTION 3: The Congress shall have power to enforce this article by appropriate legislation.

A Bill to Ban Fracking

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** No company or state will be able to obtain oil or gas through fracking
- 2 **SECTION 2.** Fracking is defined as the process of injecting liquid at high pressure into
- 3 subterranean rocks, boreholes, etc. so as to force open existing fissures and
- 4 extract oil or gas
- 5 **SECTION 3.** The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the Department of Energy
- 6 (DOE), and the Department of the Interior (DOI) shall oversee the
- 7 implementation of this legislation
- 8 A. Companies that do not follow this regulation will be fined up to
- 9 \$100,000 for each offense. After an offense, they will be given a period
- 10 of 4 months to stop the operation.
- 11 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on January 1st, 2027. All laws in conflict with
- 12 this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Require Children to be Tried as Adults in Order to Preserve the Integrity of the US

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** All children who commit particularly heinous crimes shall hereby be tried
2 as adults.
- 3 **SECTION 2.** Heinous crimes shall be defined as murder, sexual assault, armed robbing,
4 drug dealings, domestic violence, and kidnapping. Children shall be defined
5 as all persons under the age of eighteen. Adults shall be defined as
6 everyone else.
- 7 **SECTION 3.** The Department of Justice shall oversee the implementation of this
8 legislation.
9 A. Court proceedings shall continue as usual.
- 10 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on January 1st, 2028. All laws in conflict with
11 this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Provide Free Higher Education

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. Any U.S. high school student who demonstrates aptitude for higher education by attaining a minimum GPA of 3.75 and a cumulative ACCUPLACER test score of 800 and above shall be granted free tuition at any U.S. public university.

SECTION 2. This legislation shall be implemented by the United States Department of Education and the Departments of Education in all 50 states.

SECTION 3. The legislation shall take effect October 1, 2035.

SECTION 4. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
