Divisions: Three rounds of Policy – Novice and Varsity. Novice is defined as first year high school competitor. Five rounds of LD and PF – JV and Varsity. JV is defined as first- or second-year high school competitor. Please keep any oral comments after the round to a minimum.

Policy prep time is 8 minutes. LD prep time is 4 minutes. PF prep time is 3 minutes.

Topics: Policy-Arctic LD-Plea Bargaining PF- EU

Judge Requirements: 1 judge per 1-2 entries or any fraction thereof. LD and PF are separate judging pools.
