LOGISTICS

ARRIVAL

- Our dismissal bell for students is 3:30 PM.

POINTS OF ENTRY

We will have a single point of entry for each building in use:

- Main Building** = Back Doors
(located in the courtyard)
- Cafeteria** = Front Doors
(located in the courtyard)
- James H. Clark Auditorium** = Side Door Friday
(across from cafeteria)
- James H. Clark Auditorium** = Front Door Saturday
(located in the school's roundabout)
- Annex** = Front Door *(located in the courtyard)*

All buildings' single point of entries are accessed via the courtyard square.
