We will be offering all TFA events except World Schools Debate and Public Forum. We will also be offering novice divisions of Extemp, Poetry and Prose. In the case that a novice division does not make, it will be collapsed into its' counterpart. A novice is defined as a student in their first year of High School competition.

TFA Rules will be used for all events. LD will use the NSDA Sept./Oct. topic. Congress on Friday for Prelims will use items 22, 24, 26, 28, 30 and Finals will use 29, 27, 25, 23, 21. Congress on Saturday for Prelims will use 21, 23, 25, 27, 29 and Finals will use 30, 28, 26, 24, 22.

Awards will be given to the top 6 finalists in each of the individual events and Congress. In debate, the top 4 finalist will receive awards. Sweepstakes trophies will be given to the three-highest ranking school.

We will not break brackets in Debate

We will be utilizing paper ballots.

Judge Obligations are as followed:

IEs: 1 judge per 10 entries

Congress: 1 judge per 10 entries

CX; 1 judge per 3 teams LD: 1 judge per 5 entries.



The fee for missing debate judges is \$125 and \$100 for missing IE judges. We would prefer to have your judges rather than your money

A concession stand will be provided for students.

A school-approved Chaperone should be on campus with students at all times

Students in IEs may cross enter at their own risk. Students participating in CX may not cross enter in other events.
