## Competing Online From Home — Student Rules

- Compete independently. No coaching, messaging, or assistance from anyone outside the round.
- Internet use is limited to your own work within the round—no outside communication.
- Outside help for competitive advantage may result in disqualification.
- All speeches, arguments, and performances must be original student work.
- Using electronic devices means you consent to device review if a rules protest occurs.
- Tech issues (internet, power, devices) do not earn extra time or accommodations.

## Online Competition via Tabroom.com & NSDA Campus

- Have a Tabroom.com account linked to your school entry.
- Use Google Chrome for best performance.
- Log into Tabroom, open your dashboard, and click the video link for your round.
- Enter your room on time and wait for all participants and the judge.
- Cameras on while speaking; mute when not speaking.
- Rounds must stay in the official Tabroom/NSDA Campus room only.
- Only judges, competitors, and approved observers may be present.
- Judges start rounds and submit ballots through Tabroom.

Online rounds are held to the same standards of professionalism and integrity as in-person competition.
