#### **Event Rules**

We will use NCFL rules for all events, with the exception of Impromptu Speaking, which will use PHSSL rules.

#### **Double Entries**

Double entries are allowed in all speech events, excluding Student Congress. There are no double entries in Lincoln-Douglas Debate or Public Forum Debate.

## **Debate Topics**

Lincoln-Douglas Debate will use the NSDA November/December topic:

Resolved: The United States ought to rewild substantial tracts of land.

Public Forum Debate will use the NSDA November/December topic:

Resolved: The United States federal government should require technology companies to provide lawful access to encrypted communications.

### **Congress Legislation**

Please submit one piece of legislation per school no later than **Wednesday**, **October 29**, **2025**. Upload your bills directly to Tabroom.com. The bill packet will be posted on **Friday**, **October 31**, **2025**. Please note we will pre-set our agenda for the preliminary rounds when the packet is posted.
