A Bill to Restrict Land Purchases by Foreign Governments and Entities

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1	SECTION 1.	The United States shall impose restrictions on the purchase of agricultural
2		and critical infrastructure land by foreign governments and foreign
3		state-controlled entities.
4	SECTION 2.	A. "Foreign government" shall refer to any sovereign nation or political
5		subdivision thereof.
6		B. "State-controlled entity" shall refer to any organization where 25% or
7		more of ownership or voting power is held by a foreign government.
8		C. "Critical infrastructure land" shall include property within 50 miles of
9		military installations, power plants, or strategic data centers, as defined by
10		the Department of Defense.
11	SECTION 3.	A. The Department of the Treasury, through the Committee on Foreign
12		Investment in the United States (CFIUS), shall oversee enforcement of this
13		legislation.
14		B. CFIUS shall review, approve, or deny foreign land purchase applications
15		based on national security assessments
16		C. The Department of Agriculture (USDA) shall maintain a public registry of
17		all foreign-owned agricultural land, updated annually
18	SECTION 4.	Foreign governments or entities already owning U.S. land prior to the
19		enactment of this bill shall retain ownership but must disclose holdings to
20		CFIUS within 180 days.
21	SECTION 5.	This legislation will take effect on July 1, 2026. All laws in conflict with this
22		legislation are hereby declared null and void.
