A Bill to Create a Corporate Carbon Tax

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1	SECTION 1.	Corporations emitting over 10,000 metric tons of CO2 annually must pay a
2		carbon tax of \$40 per metric ton over the limit.
3	SECTION 2.	Emissions refers to, but is not limited to, direct emissions from facilities,
4		vehicles, and industrial processes as well as indirect emissions from
5		electricity use.
6	SECTION 3.	The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Internal Revenue Service
7		(IRS) shall be taxed with the enforcement of this legislation.
8		A. \$400 million annually from tax revenue shall be allocated to the EPA
9		and IRS for enforcement, compliance monitoring, audits, and
10		maintaining digital reporting systems.
11		B. The EPA is tasked with setting measurement standards and the IRS shall
12		be tasked with the collection of the tasks.
13		C. Penalties of \$500,000 USD will apply for each incidence of false or
14		incomplete reporting.
15		D. Revenues will fund renewable energy research, public transit, and
16		support for pollution-impacted communities.
17	SECTION 4.	This legislation will take effect on January 1st, 2027. All laws in conflict with
18		this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
