A Bill to Subsidize Accessible Infrastructure

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1	SECTION 1.	An additional 600 million dollars annually shall be allocated to maintain
2		and establish accessible infrastructure across the United States.
3	SECTION 2.	Accessible infrastructure is defined as infrastructure built and designed to
4		be used by all individuals, regardless of physical or mental ability.
5	SECTION 3.	The U.S. Access Board will be tasked with the allocation of funds
6		A. The U.S. Access Board will create a system to receive requests for funds
7		and will distribute funds based on need.
8		B. 600 million dollars annually will be reallocated from the Department of
9		War
10		C. The U.S. Access Board will be advised to take consideration to allocate
11		funds equally between rural and urban requests.
12	SECTION 4.	This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2027. All laws in conflict with
		this legislation will be declared null and void.
