

Louisburg HS Debate Invitational Saturday Nov. 22nd, 2025 Novice/Open Division

Greetings Fellow Debate Coaches,

You and your debaters are cordially invited to attend the annual Louisburg Invitational Debate Tournament on Saturday <u>November 22nd, 2025</u>. This year I will be using tabroom and could use any help. We will be hosting only a <u>Novice & Open Division</u>. This will be a one day only tournament with <u>five</u> rounds.

We won't be using the novice packet.

Each school will be required to bring 1 judge for the tournament.

Tournament Regulations--LHS

- 1. We will debate the current 2025 NSDA topic. **Resolved: The United States** federal government should significantly increase its exploration and/or development of the Arctic.
- 2. Entry fees are \$5 per team.
- 3. We will accept a maximum of <u>four</u> teams from each school until we reach our room capacity. This will be <u>35-40 two person team entries total</u>.

We will limit to 8 schools and no more than a total of 12 entries on <u>Tabroom, extras will be granted the week of the tournament, pending judge</u> <u>recruitments.</u> Once we hit our 8 schools, you will be waitlisted.

- 4. Any team more than 10 minutes late to a round, through no fault of the tournament, will forfeit the round and receive a loss on 3-4.
- 5. We will pre-set rounds 1 & 2 and then power match rounds 3, 4, & 5.
- 6. Most of our judges will be parents of the students. Lay judges.
- 7. Medals will be given to the top 6 entries in each division, and Sweepstakes plaques will be given to the top 3 schools.

<u>Sweepstakes plaques</u> will be awarded to the top three schools based on the cumulative record of your best 4 teams, with one being in the Open Division.

- 8. Judges provided by a team must be out of high school. THEY MUST BE AVAILABLE THE WHOLE DAY. Some may be put on standby based upon the number of judges available. *Each school will be required to bring 1 judge.*
- 9. Final numbers are due by Wednesday Nov 19th, 2025 by 3:05 p.m.
- 10. In each round, a student helper will check to verify everyone is present and clear the round to begin.
- 11. Lunch option is a "Potato Bar" with water and a cookie for \$5.
