## Bardstown Tiger Jr/Sr Swing Tournament January 31, 2026

Happy January! We are pleased to invite you to the 2nd Annual Bardstown Tiger Jr./Sr. Swing Tournament! This is our last invitational before Regional Tournaments, so let's make it a great one! There are a few changes from last year we want to make you aware of:

- Bardstown High School is the sole host of this tournament. BHS students will not be competing. Bardstown Middle School students, however, will. All of Bardstown's regular judges will be blocked from BMS students.
- Due to construction, we have lost access to some rooms. The schedule may need to be adjusted after registration closes, depending on the number of entries.
- There will be two student common areas, both nearby each other.

### VENUE

Competition rooms will take place in Bardstown Middle, High, and Polytech buildings. Registration will be in the High School lobby, which is on the second floor of the building closest to 5<sup>th</sup> street. Cars and buses may use any parking lot on the campus.

## JUDGES

You must provide one judge for every six entries or fraction thereof; 7 entries = 2 judges, etc. All judges must have a linked Tabroom.com account to be registered. They must provide their own laptop or tablet for judging; a cell phone is not ideal. Your judges should be familiar with the [KHSSL rules](#). Schools must provide at least one judge per competition area (IE and Congress). All judges should be prepared to judge both Junior and Senior categories.

## TOC BIDS

If 24 or fewer competitors enter, the top 3 receive bids.

If 25 to 72 people compete, the top 7 finalists receive bids.

If 73 to 125 or more are in an event, the top 14 semifinalists receive bids

If 125 or more are in an event, the top 24 quarterfinalists receive bids.

\*A bid in prose OR poetry counts towards qualification in Oral Interpretation.
