A Bill to Institute the 50-Year Mortgage

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Mortgage lenders throughout the United States and its territories are directed to begin offering homebuyers the option of a 50-year mortgage and to make this option as attractive and affordable as possible.

SECTION 2. This legislation shall be overseen by the Federal Housing Finance Agency (FHFA).

SECTION 3. This legislation shall take effect sixty (60) days after passage.

SECTION 4. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Reinstate the Fairness Doctrine

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) is hereby ordered to
3 reinstate the Fairness Doctrine. That is, all holders of broadcast licenses
4 are henceforth required to regularly devote airtime to controversial
5 issues and to ensure that contrasting viewpoints on these issues are
6 given reasonably fair and equal representation.

7 **SECTION 2.** This legislation shall be overseen by the FCC, which shall specifically be
8 tasked with setting and enforcing standards of fair broadcasting.

9 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall take effect thirty (30) days following passage.

10 **SECTION 4.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill for Font Approachability and Accessibility

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** All federal documentation, webpages, and signage shall henceforth be
3 presented in Comic Sans MS font with a minimum size of 14-point
4 (excluding footnotes, endnotes, and other subsidiary text).

5 **SECTION 2.** All Executive departments must adhere to this legislation and are
6 required to seek and secure Congressional approval for any exceptions.

7 **SECTION 3.** All federal webpages must be updated to adhere to this legislation within
8 thirty (30) days of passage. This legislation does not require replacement
9 of text that has already been printed or engraved, but shall apply
10 henceforth to replacements and anything new.

11 **SECTION 4.** States and territories are encouraged to enact similar legislation as soon
12 as is practicable.

13 **SECTION 5.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.

14 **SECTION 6.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
