A Resolution to Call for the Inclusion of Gridiron Football at the Olympics

1 **WHEREAS** Gridiron football—also known as American football, tackle football, or
2 simply football—is one of the most popular and lucrative sports in the
3 world and by far the most popular form of football; and

4 **WHEREAS** There are professional leagues playing this sport throughout North
5 America, Europe, and Asia; and

6 **WHEREAS** The element of tackling is an iconic and essential feature of this sport
7 which truly puts athletes’ physicality to the test and without which the
8 game becomes little more than a farce; now, therefore be it

9 **RESOLVED** by the Congress here assembled that the International Olympic
10 Committee is directed to incorporate gridiron football in place of flag
11 football as a mandatory Olympic event as soon as possible; and be it

12 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that Congress strongly implores the City of Los Angeles to make
13 the inclusion of gridiron football a requirement of hosting the
14 Summer Olympics in 2028; and be it

15 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that Congress warns the International Olympic Committee and
16 Team USA that federal funding for the Olympics may be
17 withdrawn if these recommendations are not heeded.

A Resolution to Amend the Constitution to Enfranchise the Incarcerated

1 **RESOLVED,** That the following article is proposed as an amendment to the
2 Constitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all intents and
3 purposes as part of the Constitution when ratified by the legislatures of
4 three-fourths of the several states within seven years from the date of its
5 submission by the Congress:

6 **ARTICLE —**

7 **SECTION 1.** The right of those who are incarcerated to vote shall not be infringed at
8 any point leading up to, during, or after their sentence, regardless of the
9 details or scope of their crime or punishment.

10 **SECTION 2.** It is the affirmative duty of states and territories to ensure that the
11 incarcerated face no undue barriers impeding them in the free exercise of
12 this right.

13 **SECTION 3.** The Congress shall have power to enforce this article by appropriate
14 legislation.

A Bill to Designate America First Flag Day as a Federal Holiday

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** America First Flag Day (June 14) shall be recognized as a federal holiday,
3 with a national military parade to be held each year on this day in the
4 nation's capital.

5 **SECTION 2.** On America First Flag Day, all non-essential federal government offices
6 shall be closed, stock market trading shall be suspended, and every
7 federal government employee shall be paid for a normal day's work.
8 State and local governments and private businesses are strongly
9 encouraged to observe America First Flag Day in similar fashion as they
10 are able.

11 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall take effect on June 1, 2026.

12 **SECTION 4.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
