A Bill to Reclaim Congressional War Powers

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** The Authorization for Use of Military Force of 2001 (AUMF; Pub. L. 107–
3 40, 115 Stat. 224) is hereby repealed.

4 **SECTION 2.** The President shall once again require the consent of Congress in order
5 to use military force preemptively.

6 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.

7 **SECTION 4.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Delineate the Rights of the Press to Enter Places of Worship

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** No person, including any journalist or other member of the press, may
3 enter a private place of worship without the consent of the legal owner
4 or an authorized representative.

5 **SECTION 2.** Should a journalist or other member of the press violate this legislation,
6 they shall be held liable to relevant trespassing statutes the same as any
7 other person would be.

8 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be overseen by the Department of Justice.

9 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.

10 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Ban Handleless Car Doors

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** All automobiles sold or manufactured in the United States shall
3 henceforth be required to have mechanical handles on all doors.

4 **SECTION 2.** An automobile is defined as a self-propelled passenger vehicle
5 manufactured for use on public roads, and a mechanical handle is
6 defined as a hand-operated implement that opens a door on an
7 automobile through mechanical means alone (without requiring
8 electricity).

9 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be overseen by the U.S. Office of Government Ethics
10 (OGE).

11 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.

12 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
