## The Cryptocurrency Limitation against Executive Abuse and Nefariousness (CLEAN) Act

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** The President, Vice President, and all Executive cabinet members are  
3 prohibited from acquiring, holding, accessing, soliciting, accepting, and  
4 otherwise interacting with their own digital assets while holding  
5 Executive office.

6 **SECTION 2.** Any digital assets held by any such Officers at the time of implementation  
7 must be placed into a qualified blind trust. The same shall be expected of  
8 any such assets of newly elected or appointed Executive Officers  
9 henceforth. Failure to comply shall be deemed an impeachable offense.

10 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be overseen by the U.S. Office of Government Ethics  
11 (OGE).

12 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.

13 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

## A Resolution to Recommend the Abandonment of Snow-Day Makeups

1       **WHEREAS**       Safety should be the top and sole priority when a school district is  
2                           determining whether to cancel school due to inclement weather; and  
3       **WHEREAS**       Stress about a school year extending into summer vacation can cause  
4                           administrators to hesitate to make the safe call; and  
5       **WHEREAS**       Educators are masters of adaptation and flexibility and can adjust their  
6                           curricula as necessary even should there be an unusual number of snow  
7                           days; and  
8       **WHEREAS**       A true snow day, in which school is fully canceled and students are  
9                           temporarily liberated from academic expectations, is a time-honored  
10                          tradition and a legitimate silver lining of life in the colder and snowier  
11                          parts of our country; now, therefore be it  
12       **RESOLVED**     by the Congress here assembled that departments of education  
13                          throughout the United States and its territories are encouraged to  
14                          remove requirements that snow days be made up, whether that be  
15                          through remote learning days or by extending the school year in any  
16                          manner.

## **A Resolution to Amend the Constitution to Nationalize Federal Elections**

1       **RESOLVED,**       That the following article is proposed as an amendment to the  
2                               Constitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all intents and  
3                               purposes as part of the Constitution when ratified by the legislatures of  
4                               three-fourths of the several states within seven years from the date of its  
5                               submission by the Congress:

6       **ARTICLE —**

7               **SECTION 1.**   All federal elections—that is, elections to offices at the federal level—  
8                               shall henceforth be administered entirely by the federal government.

9               **SECTION 2.**   Each state and territory shall be required to supply funding and staffing  
10                              to the federal government commensurate with what they have  
11                              historically committed to elections yet to be regularly adjusted to reflect  
12                              changes in demographics and economics.

13              **SECTION 3.**   The Congress shall have power to enforce this article by appropriate  
14                              legislation.
