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## **A Bill to End the U.S. Military Presence in Okinawa**

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** Congress shall defund all U.S. military operations in Japan's Okinawa  
3 Prefecture over a period of two (2) years.

4 **SECTION 2.** The Department of Defense is directed to begin closing all Okinawa  
5 bases and reassigning all personnel currently stationed in Okinawa  
6 immediately in order to conclude operations prior to the end of this  
7 funding.

8 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be overseen by the Department of Defense.

9 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect at the start of the next fiscal year.

10 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

## A Bill to Enforce the TikTok Ban

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

**SECTION 1.** Per the Protecting Americans from Foreign Adversary Controlled Applications Act (Pub. L. 118–50, 138 Stat. 955), the prohibition on the following is reaffirmed: “a foreign adversary controlled application [...] directly or indirectly operated by (1) ByteDance, Ltd. or TikTok (including subsidiaries or successors that are controlled by a foreign adversary); or (2) a social media company that is controlled by a foreign adversary and has been determined by the President to present a significant threat to national security.”

**SECTION 2.** The January 2026 deal to avert this ban by divesting TikTok’s U.S. operations to the newly created TikTok USDS Joint Venture LLC is declared to have been a fake divestiture since ByteDance continues to code the application. Only a divestiture that totally divorces ByteDance from TikTok shall suffice if the app is to evade this ban.

**SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be overseen by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC).

**SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect 30 days from passage.

**SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

## A Bill to Ban Guns at Protests

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** Firearms are hereby banned at all protests, regardless of whether an  
3 individual possesses licensing or permits that would otherwise enable  
4 them to carry.

5 **SECTION 2.** Each state and territory is directed to regard protests as “sensitive places”  
6 (as defined in the Supreme Court decision District of Columbia v. Heller  
7 and reaffirmed in New York State Rifle & Pistol Association v. Bruen) and  
8 to apply penalties for violation of this legislation accordingly.

9 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be overseen by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco,  
10 Firearms and Explosives (ATF).

11 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.

12 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
