(as per rule X.B.4. on page 47: *For Class A, any speech and/or drama event with 15 or fewer entries: raw scores will be used for preliminary rounds and Semifinals will not be held. (Note: remove truncate rank from all tiebreakers in Tabroom and this is an exception to procedures in VIII.B). It must be used for all events with fewer than 15 entries. Sweepstakes points for Semifinals will not be awarded if they are not held.*

All events will be held at the High School/Middle School campus area. Concessions will be available in the student gathering area. Map is attached.

On-site check-in is Thursday night, January 29, from 7:00 – 9:00 pm. Late check-in will be Friday morning from 9:30-10:00. (**No student off-loading until 10:00 am.**)

Lincoln-Douglas Debate – 2026 January/February Topic
