# **ENTRIES & MULTIPLE ENTRY RULES**

- The tournament is open to Junior High competitors only.
- Students may enter up to two (2) events per flight.
- There are no entry caps per event or per school.
- For team sweepstakes, only the top three (3) entries in each category from each school will count.
- **Substitutions** may be made the morning of the competition at registration.

# **TOURNAMENT FEES**

- Single event entry: \$6.00
- Double entry (Duo Acting, Duo Improvisational): \$12.00 per team

#### Late Drops (after the posted deadline on Tabroom):

- \$10.00 per single event
- \$20.00 per duo event

Schools are financially responsible for all entries and judges on the Tabroom roster as of the drop deadline.

# **JUDGES**

- Each school is required to provide **one** (1) judge for every six (6) entries or fraction thereof.
  - Example: 6 entries = 1 judge; 7 entries = 2 judges.
- Judge Hire Fee: \$40.00 per uncovered judge
- **Dropped Judge Fee:** \$50.00 per judge dropped after the deadline

#### We would much rather have your judges than your money!

#### **Judge Expectations**

- All judges should be familiar with KHSSL rules and ballots.
- All judges must have a Tabroom.com account and be linked to your school on Tabroom.
- Judges are expected to bring a **charged device** (laptop or tablet preferred) to complete online ballots; judging on a phone is strongly discouraged.
- Judges should attend the **judges' meeting at 8:30 a.m.** to receive final instructions and room assignments.

# **RULES**

The Patriot Winter Classic will follow **all KHSSL rules** for junior high speech events, including time limits, use of manuscripts, and restrictions on materials.

# **AWARDS**

- **Medals** will be awarded to competitors placing **1st through 6th** in each event.
- "Next-Out" awards will be given for 7th place in each event where entry numbers allow.
- Sweepstakes trophies will be awarded to the top-performing schools.

# **LUNCH & CONCESSIONS**

A **full concession stand** will be available on site for students and guests, featuring items such as hot dogs, nachos, chili-in-a-bag, snacks, and drinks. Concessions will be **cash only**.

A **hospitality room** will be provided for **judges**, **coaches**, **and bus drivers**, and we intend to keep you happily fed and caffeinated throughout the day.

# **DUCKY ADOPTION: COMMUNITY-BUILDING ACTIVITY**

We are excited to introduce a fun new community-building event at this year's Patriot Winter Classic—our **Ducky Adoption Station**!

Students may "adopt" a rubber ducky for \$1. Each duck will feature **one half of a two-part word** (example: one duck reads *Snow*, the other reads *Flake*). Throughout the day, students will have the opportunity to **find the speechie who has the matching half of their word**.

This activity encourages:

- cross-team mingling
- meeting new friends
- practicing communication
- building a welcoming, collaborative atmosphere

All proceeds go toward supporting the Knott County Central Speech Team. We hope your students will participate and enjoy this lighthearted way to connect with fellow competitors!
