

NSDA DISTRICT REGISTRATION CHECKLIST

- Payment for entries - Cash or a check made out to Purple Sage NSDA District.
- Payment for NSDA fees owed - if applicable. These must be paid BEFORE we start round 1.
- School Consent Form - found on Tabroom - printed out and signed
- Preferences, aka what used to be known as a Single-entry letter of intent—one for EVERY student who will be competing in more than one event, INCLUDING BQ, congress, and World Schools debate.
These MUST be in the computer and each cross-entered student must have a signed form, with preferences indicated, turned in at registration.
- Copy of all oratories with quoted words highlighted or underlined, a bibliography, and a Statement of originality signed by both the coach and the student. This is due to Savanna Winn by February 7th by 4:00 PM. swinn@seminoleisd.net
- Sources of ALL interpretation selections turned in. Here is what counts per page 46-47 in the Unified Manual.
 - *Print publications — physical book or ebook
 - *Digital printed publications (like web pages) —publicly accessible for viewing by simple internet search or by URL — we need to have the URL
 - *PDFs—publicly accessible for viewing by simple internet search or by URL
 - *Digital unprinted publications (like videos, audio files, films) - publicly accessible for viewing by simple internet search or by URL — MUST present an official transcript — one that is approved by the original source's publisher, licensing agent, or copyright holder
- Scripts turned in — You will not be turning this in at registration BUT we will be checking it at registration. Also, you will have to send it in when you qualify for Nationals!!! ☺
- Titles in Tabroom for OO, Info, POI, DI, HI, and Duo
- Acknowledgment that your administration is aware of and approves the cutting content performed in OO, Info, DI, HI, and DUO (this is for Texas SB 12)
- World Schools Debate team applications with all required signatures
- coach judge form with email used for Tabroom account (you will fill out at registration)
