Event Rules

We will use NCFL rules for all events, except Impromptu Speaking and Storytelling, which will use PHSSL rules.

Double Entries

Double entries are allowed in all speech events, excluding Student Congress. There are no double entries in Lincoln-Douglas Debate or Public Forum Debate.

Debate Topics

Lincoln-Douglas Debate will use the NSDA January/February topic:

Resolved: The possession of nuclear weapons is immoral.

Public Forum Debate will use the NSDA February topic:

Registration

NOTE: Entry fees will be adjusted at the close of registration to reflect CFLS payment plan discounts.

Teams that withdraw their complete entry after 5 p.m. on Wednesday, February 4, 2026, will be asked to pay a nuisance fee equal to 50% of their registration fee.

Judge Requirements

*1 judge for every 5 Speech or Congress entries or fraction thereof. A Duo team counts as one entry.

*1 judge for every 2 Public Forum teams or fraction thereof

*1 judge for every 2 Lincoln-Douglas debaters or fraction thereof

Judges are expected to be available for the entire day.
