I am delighted to invite you to the **2025 McMinnville High School Speech Invitational**, hosted **in person on Saturday, January 31, 2026**, at McMinnville High School. We are excited to welcome you and look forward to working together to create a tournament that is efficient, competitive, safe, and enjoyable for everyone involved.

Events & Entry Information

This year, we will be offering **all OSAA speech events**, as well as **Congress and SPAR**.

Events Offered (Open Division):

Humorous, Dramatic, Duo, Poetry, Prose, Informative, Oratory, Extemp, Impromptu, After Dinner Speaking (ADS), Program Oral Interpretation (POI), LIELL, Radio
Additionally: **SPAR** and **Congress**

Events NOT offered: Parliamentary Debate, Public Forum, Lincoln-Douglas

Double Entry Rules

- Speech/SPAR competitors may double enter **at their own risk**
 - Congress may **not** double enter
 - Extemp and SPAR may **not** be double entered

- Students may enter **up to two individual events total**

Each school may enter **up to four (4) entries per event** during initial registration.

Entry Caps & Waitlist

To ensure we can accommodate all attending schools within our space limitations, entries will be capped at **four entries per event** during initial registration. If space allows, coaches will be notified and entry caps may be relaxed. Additional entries will be pulled from the waitlist as fairly and realistically as possible.

Once building capacity is reached, all additional entries will be waitlisted.

Judge Requirements

For every **four (4) entries** (not students), each school **must provide one judge**.

Example:
16 entries = 4 judges

Judges must:

- Meet all volunteer requirements of their school district
- Be available to judge **every round of the day**
- Be prepared for **four total rounds**

I recognize this is a demanding judge requirement. However, this structure allows the tournament to run efficiently, limits the total number of people in the building, and ensures we conclude by **5:00 PM**. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and support.

Congress

- **Two sessions of Congress** will be held
- Congress legislation is due **January 22**
