Parking and Drop-off: Teams may arrive any time after 2:45 p.m. Students should be dropped off at the Wells Street entrance (corner of Water and Wells).

Parking options:

- Associated Bank Theater Center underground garage across Water Street. The overhead clearance is low, so full-size vans should opt for street parking.
- Street parking should be available near City Hall. Meters are unfortunately no longer free after 6:00pm, as was the case last year. The meters accept credit cards, or you may use the ParkMobile app to feed your meter remotely.

Linking Students in Tabroom: All competitors will need a Tabroom account linked to your team roster. \

Judges: One well-trained judge for every eight Congress entries. Judges are obligated for both sessions.

Only legislation uploaded to Tabroom by Thursday, January 22 at noon will be allowed during the chambers' debate.
