A Resolution to Recognize Interspecies Marriage Rights

- WHEREAS,** Love knows no boundaries, species, or lily pads;
- WHEREAS,** The Constitution guarantees equal protection under the law to all individuals, making no distinction between porcine and amphibian citizens;
- WHEREAS,** Numerous successful interspecies relationships exist in our society, demonstrating that mutual respect, communication, and occasional karate chops can sustain any partnership;
- WHEREAS,** Current laws create unnecessary bureaucratic obstacles for couples of different species who wish to formalize their committed relationships;
- WHEREAS,** Denying marriage rights based solely on species classification constitutes an arbitrary and outdated form of discrimination;
- WHEREAS,** The recognition of interspecies marriage would promote tolerance, diversity, and acceptance in our communities;
- WHEREAS,** All beings deserve the right to marry the frog—or other creature—of their dreams; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED,** That the Congress supports the legal recognition of marriage between consenting adults regardless of species classification; and be it
- FURTHER RESOLVED,** That states be encouraged to remove species-based restrictions from marriage licensing requirements; and be it
- FURTHER RESOLVED,** That appropriate accommodations be made for interspecies ceremonies, including but not limited to pond-side venues and insect-based catering options.

A Bill to Ban the Creation of Powerful Rings to Eliminate Further Evil

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** All creation of rings intended for claiming evil power and control over
2 others will be hereby banned. This will ensure no dark evils, such as the
3 dark lord Sauron, can come into power, and all power will be shared
4 equally between all of the races and kingdoms. All rings found to have been
5 made during this permanent ban will be immediately thrown into the fires
6 of Mt. Doom and destroyed.
- 7 **SECTION 2.** “Powerful rings” shall be defined as rings, like the Ring of Power (also
8 known as the One Ring), that take power over the owner and strive for evil
9 and control.
10 “Kingdoms in Middle Earth” shall be defined as the kingdoms of Rohan,
11 Gondor, Mirkwood, Rivendell, and the kingdoms of the Dwarves, such as
12 that of the Lonely Mountain.
13 “The Fellowship of the Ring” shall be defined as those who went on the
14 quest to destroy the Ring of Power. These include the hobbits Frodo
15 Baggins, Samwise Gamgee, Merry and Pippin; the humans Boromir and
16 Aragorn, the elf Legolas, the dwarf Gimli, and the wizard Gandalf.
- 17 **SECTION 3.** The leaders of all of the kingdoms in Middle Earth and the remaining
18 Fellowship of the Ring will oversee the carrying out of this bill. These
19 kingdoms will maintain rigorous oversight of the happenings in Mordor to
20 prevent any nefarious Orc activity.
- 21 A. Funding for this bill will come primarily from the gold stash previously
22 hoarded by Smaug in the Lonely Mountain (Erebor) and provided by
23 the dwarves who have since taken control of it.
- 24 B. Anyone found to have violated this bill will be required to pay
25 significant fines and forfeit any earnings to date.
- 26 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect upon passage.
- 27 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Initiate Construction of an educational structure at Camp Half-Blood

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- SECTION 1.** An educational structure will be constructed at Camp Half-Blood. Construction will be overseen by the children of Hephaestus, and the design will be completed by Annabeth Chase, alleged architect of Olympus. The structure will be constructed from marble and large enough to host both typical school classes and specified classes for demigods at varying levels of difficulty. This will allow year-round education for demigods at the camp.
- SECTION 2.** The following definitions apply:
- A. A Half-blood is defined as a child of a mortal and one of the gods on Olympus. These children are often targeted and attacked by monsters upon reaching thirteen or younger. They often require additional education because they cannot attend a regular school safely without risking harm, and to learn more about Greek mythology, which is crucial to their future.
 - B. Camp Halfblood is defined as a sanctuary for half-bloods where they are safe from the harm of monsters. It is located on Long Island, New York. While inside its boundaries, monsters can not attack the one inside. The camp director is Mr. D (Dyonysis), and the activity director is Chiron (trainer of Hercules). The camp trains Half-Bloods to become heroes or simply survive in the world.
 - C. A typical class is defined as any class in the educational structure that would be taught in normal circumstances. This includes but is not limited to any class in the field of literature, science, social studies, or math
- SECTION 3.** This bill would be funded by the Gods of Olympus, who have agreed to provide all required materials or funds needed for construction, to ensure the future of more Demigod heroes if the bill is passed by Congress
- SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on the 18th of August, 2026. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Add A Conspiracy Investigation Branch to the FBI

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

A Bill to Subsidize Hunny for All Citizens in the Hundred Acre Wood

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 hunny to ensure the happiness and well-being of all residents.

3 **SECTION 2.** For the purposes of this legislation, "hunny" shall be defined as the sweet,

6 resident.

A Resolution to Build the Death Star

- WHEREAS,** A sufficiently large impact by an asteroid or other NEOs would cause, depending on their impact location, massive tsunamis or multiple firestorms, and an impact winter caused by the sunlight-blocking effect of placing large quantities of pulverized rock dust, and other debris, into the stratosphere; and
- WHEREAS,** Astronomical events, such as the Shoemaker-Levy 9 impacts on Jupiter and the Chelyabinsk meteor, along with the growing number of objects on the Sentry Risk Table, have drawn renewed attention to such threats; and
- WHEREAS,** Several ways of avoiding an asteroid impact have been described. Nonetheless, in March 2019, scientists reported that asteroids may be much more difficult to destroy than previously thought. In addition, an asteroid may reassemble itself due to gravity after being disrupted; and
- WHEREAS,** Aspirational space missions like the manned mission to the moon created new inventions and techniques that spread into public life, many of which are taken for granted today; and
- WHEREAS,** Many elements of science fiction have become reality, such as the mobile phone, universal translator, 3d holograms, tablets, and space stations; and
- WHEREAS,** Building the Death Star would force humanity to colonize the moon and mine asteroids, which are instrumental for advanced space flight, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED,** That the Congress here assembled direct and fund the Space Force and NASA to build a 1/4 sized Death Star to advance science, space exploration, and to defend against the existential threat of an asteroid impact to the only home we have.
