Please join us in-person at Fairview High School in Boulder, CO. Register on Tabroom.com.

A coach or responsible adult must be on-site at all times and checked in to judge or in Tab.

Registration & Dates:

- Pre-registration due via Taboom: Monday, February 16 @ 7pm mtn. Drops after this may be made online but will not reduce fees.
- Judges due: Wednesday, February 18 @ 7pm mtn. **Excessive entries without enough judges to cover them may be dropped at this point.**

Entries & Costs:

- Initial entry limit of 6 per event, but we anticipate clearing the waitlist.
- \$12 per speaking/interp events; \$24 per debate events; \$10 Middle School and Congress.
- We welcome and want everyone to participate so please reach out if costs are prohibitive.
- Pay by credit card. Checks if needed: Fairview High School c/o Speech & Debate Team.

Judges:

- Each school is responsible for providing trained judges to cover their entries throughout the day. We will recruit heavily and view recruiting judges as a community endeavor.
- Provide 1 judge for every 2 debate entries or every 6 IEs.
- We will not pay judges who are meeting a school's judging requirement, except alumni.
- We know how difficult finding judges can be: please reach out if this is prohibitive.
- Judges are responsible for checking for ballots at the appropriate times.
- All judges will be asked to reflect on their unconscious biases prior to judging.

Events & Doubling Rules:

- Events: CX, PF, LD, Humor, Drama, Original Oratory, Info, US Extemp, Int'l Extemp, Duo, Poetry, POI, and Congress + Middle School: PF & Platform (OO, Info, POI)
- Events use NSDA rules with NSDA topics.
- Doubling between waves is encouraged, but debaters may not double enter in debate and extempers cannot double in both extemps.
- Students in IEs may double enter in two events within the same wave with the responsibility to get to rounds.
- Doubled students are responsible for getting to events and may not receive full prep time.
- For the tournament to run an event, there must be at least four (4) registered competitors/teams (10 in Congress) by Monday, February 16th.
- Congress legislation is due by February 14 at 7pm to fhsdebate@gmail.com. Will send out on Feb 15.

Schedule:

- Rounds will be run as quickly as possible: postings may be earlier than scheduled
- The goal is to single flight LD and PF
- Wave A: CX, PF, HI, DI, OO, INF, IX, Congress A
- Wave B: LD, Duo, PI, POI, NX, Congress B
- We will offer Middle School **PF, Platform (OO, Info, POI) and Impromptu**

Round 1 Wave B: 9:30 AM; Middle School round 2

Round 2 Wave A: 10:45 AM; Middle School round 3

Round 2 Wave B: 12:00 PM

Middle School Awards: 12:30pm

Round 3 Wave A: 1:30 PM

Round 3 Wave B: 2:45 PM

Finals: 4:30 PM (Double breaks will be accommodated as needed), Next-in for 40+ events (goal)

Awards: 6:30 PM or as soon as possible

Tabulation:

- All debate rounds will be powered.
- All undefeated debaters will break to finals or a 4th round, subject to judge availability.
- Places will be determined by win-loss, strength of opp, and speaker points.
- Team awards by percentage of entries breaking to a finals round, not total numbers.

Day of Event: Drop entries by 7:20 AM. If late, call or text Kristina Getty at 303-710-5091.

School Logistics:

- Enter from the top part of the school where registration will take place.
- All cars and buses should park in the lot to the west of the school.
- Fairview ramps are STEEP, please keep your students from running or playing on them.
- Fast food is not available within walking distance, food will be available for purchase.
- Breakfast, lunch, and snacks will be provided for judges and coaches.
- Students are expected to remain in the Student Center when not competing.
- Please do not enter classrooms before judges are present.
- Note that all tobacco use and products are not permitted on the Fairview campus.
