A Bill to Increase Voter Turnout by Creating a Tax Credit for Voters

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** 26 U.S. Code Subtitle A Chapter 1 Subchapter A Part IV Subpart A (listing
3 nonrefundable personal tax credits) is amended by inserting text
4 establishing a tax credit of \$50 to be offered to any person who votes in
5 any regularly scheduled election to determine the holder of any federal
6 office.

7 **SECTION 2.** The credit issued through this legislation shall only be issued to any
8 individual once per year in which they voted in a qualifying election.

9 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be implemented by the Internal Revenue Service.

10 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2027. All laws in conflict with
11 this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Expand Requirements to Become an Elected Official

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1 **SECTION 1.** Stricter regulations shall be implemented regarding eligibility
2 for election to federal office. Candidates may not have a criminal record in
3 order to be eligible for election to positions such as the Presidency,
4 Congress, or appointment to the Supreme Court.

5 **SECTION 2.** A criminal record is hereby defined as any recorded
6 conviction under federal, state, or local law.

7 **SECTION 3.** The role of the Federal Election Commission will be expanded
8 to induce vetting and auditing of candidates to federal office.

9 A. Vetting would occur once a candidate has formally filed their petition
10 to appear on an election ballot.

11 B. The FEC would work alongside state and local election officials to
12 ensure compliance.

13 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on July 1, 2027. All laws in
14 conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Require Disclosure of Artificial Intelligence-Generated Political Content

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** Any political advertisement or media content generated
3 substantially using artificial intelligence shall be required to include a
4 clear disclosure stating such use.

5 **SECTION 2.** Artificial intelligence-generated content shall be defined
6 as audio, visual, or written material produced primarily by automated
7 systems without direct human authorship.

8 **SECTION 3.** The Federal Election Commission shall oversee
9 enforcement of this legislation.

10 A. Violations shall be subject to fines not exceeding \$50,000 per
11 infraction

12 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect six months after passage. All laws in
13 conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
