Dear Forensic Coach,

The Cardinal Forensics Team invites you to attend the HHS Invitational Forensics Tournament on **Saturday, April 4th**. You may bring up to **24 entries**. The following events will be offered:

- Extemporaneous Speech
- Combined Domestic and Foreign
- Informative Speech (7)
- Original Oration
- Impromptu Speech
- Poetry Interpretation
- Prose Interpretation
- Program of Oral Interp (POI)
- Humorous Solo Acting
- Serious Solo Acting
- Duet Acting (Duo)
- Improvised Duet Acting (IDA)

Schedule and Tournament Information:

- There will be 3 preliminary rounds and one final round.
- **JUDGES MAY ACT AS TIMEKEEPERS - per KSHSAA handbook.**
- The top six in each event will receive medals.
- Finalists and final rankings will be determined from their **cumulative totals**.
- *Sweepstakes* will be based on the **top 12 entries from the 3 preliminary rounds**.
- There will be no minimum entry to qualify for the team sweepstakes.
- There will be plaques for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd-place sweepstakes awards.
- **Each student is limited to three events and may not enter the same event twice.**
- **NOTE: Students may enter only one “Draw” or “Preparation” event, with the exception of Impromptu.**
- I ask that, for every 12 entries, you bring one extra judge, in addition to the coach.

Event Information:

- I will not be splitting Duo Interp and Duet Acting. Duet Acting Ballots will be used!
- I will not be splitting Extemp. There will be both domestic and foreign topic envelopes to draw from.
- I will not be providing Informative 10. Informative will be combined USING the KSHSAA Informative Speech rules. (No visuals).
- **The dropping of events will happen on March 31st at 4:00 PM, if the registration numbers reflect that we need to drop events.**
- **Extra entries beyond 24 per team will be allowed once I review the event caps and available rooms on March 31st.**

Drops:

- **You must let us know if you are dropping entries no later than Monday, March 30th or you will forfeit your entry fees and be responsible for paying them.**

Entry Fees:

- **Fees will be \$8 per person per entry. (IDA and Duos are \$16)**

- No Google Sheet or emailed entries will be accepted this year.

- Draws will be shared with you as a Google Doc on April 2nd. Feel free to forward the link to your students.
