

An Act to Increase the Tax on Tobacco and Nicotine Products

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** To protect the health of the people of the United States and its territories, it
3 shall increase the tax by 20% on all tobacco and nicotine products, such
4 as cigarettes, cigars, tobacco chewables, vaping products, and other
5 nicotine products.

6 **SECTION 2.** All revenue gained from this tax shall be allocated to public addiction
7 recovery programs, including public health outreach.

8 **SECTION 3.** All taxes will be collected by the Internal Revenue Service alongside
9 state revenue agencies.

10 **SECTION 4.** All funds going to public addiction recovery programs will be overseen by
11 the Department of Health and Human Services.

12 **SECTION 5.** This legislation shall take place six months after passage to allow
13 regulatory implementation and compliance.

14 **SECTION 6.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Abolish Legal Immunity for Postal Misconduct

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS ASSEMBLED HERE THAT:

Section 1: The United States shall hereby require that the United States Postal Service and its be held liable for any future miscarriage or negligent transmission of deliveries.

Section 2: A miscarriage is defined as any intentional error made by the United States Postal Service (USPS) and employees in the delivery of items. A negligent transmission is any act or failure to act in accordance with the legal duty of care towards postal transmissions.

Section 3: The Department of Justice will be responsible for overseeing this legislation.

Section 4: This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2027.

Section 5: All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void
